As supportive partners of parents, the Diocese of Erie Catholic Schools will provide a Chastity Education Program for all 5th through 8th grade students. Parents who do not wish to have their child participate must notify the principal in writing to have them excused from this curriculum. Five lessons will be provided to the 5th and 6th graders. At the 7th and 8th grade level, students will have lessons from *Theology of the Body for Teens* by Ascension Press. This program has been approved by Bishop Lawrence T. Persico for its alignment with Catholic Doctrine and Diocesan Curriculum Guidelines.
