



Restructuring Plan for Parishes in the Eastern Vicariate of the Diocese of Erie

St. Joseph (Mount Jewett) and St. Elizabeth of Hungary (Smethport)

- Merge St. Joseph Parish into St. Elizabeth of Hungary Parish
- St. Joseph becomes a secondary mission church of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Parish

This reflects a change from the preliminary plan, in that St. Joseph is now becoming a secondary mission church, which means it will have a Saturday evening or Sunday Mass.

Our Mother of Perpetual Help (Lewis Run)

St. Francis of Assisi (Bradford)

St. Bernard of Clairvaux (Bradford)

- Merge Our Mother of Perpetual Help Parish into St. Francis of Assisi Parish
- Our Mother of Perpetual Help will become a secondary mission church.
- Partner St. Francis of Assisi Parish with St. Bernard Parish

This reflects a change from the preliminary plan, in that Our Mother of Perpetual Help is now becoming a secondary mission church.

St. Theresa Parish (Shinglehouse)

St. Raphael Parish (Eldred)

St. Mary Mission (Sartwell)

- Merge St. Theresa Parish into St. Raphael Parish
- St. Theresa becomes a secondary mission church of St. Raphael Parish
- St. Mary remains a secondary mission church of St. Raphael Parish

No change from the preliminary plan.

St. Bibiana (Galeton)
Sacred Heart Mission (Genessee)
St. Augustine Mission (Austin)
St. Eulalia (Coudersport)
St. Gabriel the Archangel (Port Allegany)

- All of the proposals announced in April concerning these communities have been withdrawn.

This reflects a change from the preliminary plan, in that St. Bibiana will remain a stand-alone parishes with three churches: St. Bibiana as the parish church and Sacred Heart and St. Augustine as secondary mission churches with Sunday Mass. Also, St. Eulalia and St. Gabriel the Archangel Parishes will remain partnered.

St. Anne Parish (Wilcox)
Holy Cross Church (Rasselas)
Holy Rosary Parish (Johnsonburg)

- Merge St. Anne Parish into Holy Rosary Parish
- St. Anne Church becomes a secondary mission church of Holy Rosary Parish
- Holy Cross Parish becomes a secondary church of Holy Rosary Parish

No change from the preliminary plan.

Holy Cross Parish (Brandy Camp)
St. Boniface Parish (Kersey)

- Merge Holy Cross Parish into St. Boniface Parish
- Holy Cross becomes a secondary church of St. Boniface Parish

No change from the preliminary plan.

Christ the King (Houtzdale)
Immaculate Conception (Osceola Mills)
St. Agnes (Morrisdale)
Ss. Peter and Paul Mission (Hawk Run)

- All of the proposals announced in April concerning these communities have been withdrawn.

This reflects a change from the preliminary plan, in that Saint Agnes Parish with its secondary mission church of Ss. Peter and Paul in Hawk Run will remain partnered with Immaculate Conception Parish in Osceola Mills. Christ the King Parish in Houtzdale will remain stand-alone.

St. Basil the Great Parish (Coalport)
Holy Trinity Parish (Ramey)

- Merge Holy Trinity Parish into St. Basil the Great Parish
- Holy Trinity becomes a secondary mission church of Holy Trinity Parish

St. Bonaventure Parish (Grampian)
St. Timothy Parish (Curwensville)

- Partner St. Bonaventure Parish with St. Timothy Parish

No change from the preliminary plan.

St. Catherine of Siena Parish (DuBois)
St. Michael the Archangel Parish (DuBois)
St. Joseph Parish (DuBois)

- Merge St. Joseph Parish into St. Michael the Archangel Parish
- Partner St. Michael Parish with St. Catherine of Siena Parish

This reflects a change since the preliminary plan, in which St. Joseph was to be merged into St. Catherine Parish.

Ss. Cosmas and Damian Parish (Punxsutawney)

St. Adrian Church (Delancey)

St. Anthony of Padua Church (Walston)

St. Joseph Church (Anita)

- Correctly identify St. Adrian, St. Anthony and St. Joseph churches as secondary churches of Ss. Cosmas and Damian Parish

St. Bernard Parish (Falls Creek)

- St. Bernard will continue to stand alone, but will have a part-time, non-resident pastor with responsibilities at the hospital and Christ the King Manor.
