**Rationale for Student Inservice:** The Bishops of the United States have mandated that all children and youth be inserviced in regard to safe environment. Article 12 of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* issued by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops states:

*Dioceses will establish “safe environment” programs. They will cooperate with parents, civil authorities, educators, and community organizations to provide education and training for children, youth, parents, ministers, educators, and other about ways to make and maintain a safe environment for children.*

Two situations result in a child’s non-participation in parish sponsored safe environment programs:

1. Parents refuse to allow their children to participate in the program.
2. Children are legitimately absent from school the day the safe environment training is offered.
