

# Fr. Marconi's Jeopardy Games For Sacrament Parent Meetings

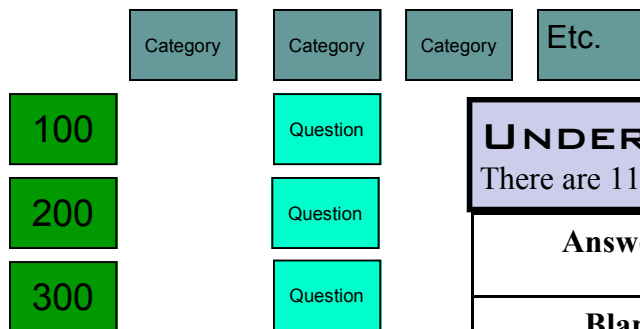
## There are two games:

A Penance Parent Meeting Version

A Eucharist Parent Meeting Version

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- ◆ This game is designed to be used on a VERY large wall space
- ◆ Arrange the 6 “Category” pages horizontally across the top
- ◆ Arrange the 5 “Number” pages vertically down the left
- ◆ It is suggested that you insert each page in a clear vinyl sheet protector and keep the entire set of sheets in a 3-ring binder.
  - ◆ This will give you holes to use to attach each page to the wall
  - ◆ This will allow you to use the game multiple times
- ◆ Hang the 5 questions for each “Category” under the appropriate heading and next to the correct number with the question facing the wall.
- ◆ Give each participant a “Blank Sheet” so they can jot down ideas and keep track of the appropriate answers.
- ◆ The game is played like the TV show - except Fr. Ted allowed participants to discuss possible answers at their table.
- ◆ Once a question is answered properly - the sheet is removed from the wall so participants can see which questions remain.

- ◆ Some questions are specific to Fr. Marconi and you will need to edit them

<b>UNDERSTANDING THE FILE NAMES:</b>	
There are 11 files for each version. (Eucharist “e-” or Penance “p-”)	
<b>Answer sheet</b>	answers
<b>Blank sheet</b>	sheet for participants to keep answers
<b>Categories</b>	large print Category Titles
<b>Final Jeopardy</b>	questions and answers for Final Jeopardy
<b>Numbers</b>	large print numbers for the wall
<b>6 files of questions</b>	questions for each of the six categories
