## Service Program Packing List

During your stay, you will need some work clothes, some causal clothes, and at least one dress outfit.

### Work Clothes (Clothes for doing chores, painting, etc.)

Old-shirts, sweaters, sweatshirts,

Jeans and/or other work pants, Work gloves and a Hat, Boots for wet, muddy days, Old Shoes and/or sneakers

Work boots for construction jobs

### Casual Clothes and Dress Clothes

(For some service experiences, everyday wear and special occasions)

Neat, Clean jeans or other pants such as khakis, Dressier type sweatshirts

Shirts and or Sweaters, Footwear

### Personal Items

Toiletries: toothbrush, toothpaste, Biodegradable soap/shampoo, (Ivory or Sauve) flip-flops or similar for showers, Drinking cup

Bible, stationary/notebook, stamps, journal, Battery clock, Flashlight, Games, Water bottle and wet ones for job sites, Bag for dirty laundry, \$ for T-shirts/Sweat shirts

### Other

Sleeping bag and/or bedding, Sheets (if desired), Robe (if desired), Pillow, Night Wear (**tasteful** clothes to sleep in), Towels, Musical Instruments, Sheet music (if needed for instruments or keyboard), Good **CLEAN** music (tapes/CD's) for prayer services, Spiritual resources for prayer services (books, music), Reading material.

### **DO NOT BRING (WORK CLOTHES)**

Pants with holes in them, Bell bottoms, Pants that hang low on the hips

**SWEAT/RUNNING/PAJAMA/ LOUNGE PANTS CANNOT BE WORN  
ON JOB SITES.**

### **DO NOT BRING (Casual/Dress)**

Low cut blouses or tops, Mini skirts or Short Shorts, Midriff, Tube, Tank or Spaghetti String tops, Baggy pants that hang lower on hips, Pants with holes in them

### **DO NOT BRING (Personal Items)**

Blow dryers (can be used when the temperature is cold- use discretion), Curling irons, Smoking items, Radios, iPods, mp3, personal tape/CD players, TV's, Personal DVD players, Personal Walkie Talkies, Cell phones for PRIVATE use, or any form of personal/handheld game systems.

### **Summer Items**

Light Weight Clothing, Modest Shorts, Water shoes for the River, Beach towels, Modest one (1) piece bathing suits for females (**NO 2-PIECE SUITS**), Tasteful trunks for males, Bug Spray, Sun block lotion, Summer Hat
