- 1. Parishes are asked to please inform the Office for Divine Worship of their plans for the October 16, 2022, diocesan-wide Eucharistic Weekend. We would like to provide publicity for events happening around the diocese. Please send your brief summary to mgrant@eriercd.org or 814.824.1271.
- 2. The U.S. National Eucharistic Revival is a good opportunity to increase the collective awareness of the spiritual events that happen annually in the parishes of the diocese. Parishes are asked to inform the Office for Divine Worship of any annual spiritual events such as Forty Hours, days of adoration, parish missions, etc., that your parish traditionally hosts. Increasing awareness of the activities in the parishes that are happening annually would be beneficial to all.
- 3. Year two of the National Eucharistic Revival encourages Eucharistic Processions at all parishes. Bishop Persico and the Office for Divine Worship are considering another approach to this idea. It will be discussed further at Presbyteral Council in October. Depending on the outcome of the discussion, further information will be made available.
