Across 13 counties, the people of the Diocese of Erie come together as ***One Faith, One Family***, united in a shared mission.

Catholic Services Appeal Impact

In 2025, **11,613 households** participated in the Catholic Services Appeal (CSA), offering gifts that were faithful, intentional and often sacrificial. With an **average gift of \$495**, donors not only helped reach the diocesan goal of **\$4.235 million**, but exceeded it—allowing **\$1.2 million raised above goal to remain directly in parishes**.

These numbers tell a deeper story: a story of shared responsibility, trust in leadership and a collective belief in the mission of the church.

IN PRAYER: Catholic Schools & Faith Formation



The Catholic Schools Office and the Office of Faith Formation help people of all ages encounter Christ. Though much of their work happens behind the scenes, its impact is evident in classrooms and parish life, where faith is lived daily as students and families pray, learn, serve and grow together.

Faith Formation



- ◆ **Confirmation Retreat attendance by 400 youth and chaperones**
- ◆ National Catholic Youth Conference (NCYC) participation by **103 youth and adults**, an increase from the previous year
- ◆ **634 catechists** serving across the diocese received support from the Faith Formation Office with **41% trained this year**
- ◆ **Hundreds** of couples received meaningful guidance, including **94 couples prepared for marriage** and **183 couples honored for milestone anniversaries**

Catholic Schools Office



- ◆ **70+ ongoing training and formation programs**

CSA helps keep Catholic education accessible through the work of CSO administrators:

- ◆ **\$1.17M STAR Foundation** aid to 1,126 students
- ◆ **\$323K Bishop's Tuition Assistance Program**
- ◆ **\$22K Student Tuition Assistance Grants** to 78 students
- ◆ **\$10K Koch Foundation** aid to 41 students




IN DISCIPLESHIP: Clergy, Sacraments & Communications

The Catholic Services Appeal directly supports the sacramental life of the church—ensuring that God’s people are accompanied with care, reverence and faith.

CSA also strengthens evangelization through communications—allowing the church’s voice to remain present, clear and welcoming.

IN SERVICE: Catholic Charities

In 2025, Catholic Charities ensured the visible presence of the church at moments of greatest need. Through 7 affiliate organizations across the diocese – funded in part by the CSA – individuals and families received support that upheld dignity and restored hope.

- ◆ Professional counseling services to over **1,000 people**
- ◆ **25,000 instances of food assistance**
- ◆ More than **13,000 hours of service** contributed by **1,817 volunteers**

These outcomes reflect the collective work of Catholic Charities and its affiliates, including Catholic Charities Counseling and Adoption Services, Christ the King Manor, Good Samaritan Center, Prince of Peace Center, Saint John XXIII Home, Saint Elizabeth of Hungary Center and Saint Martin Center.


This year's Catholic Services Appeal theme, **In Christ, We are One: Encounter · Live · Share**, reminds us of this.
