

# Diocese of Erie Eucharistic Revival Student Visual Art & Video Contest 2023

The Diocese of Erie, in conjunction with the Catholic Church throughout the United States, is in the first year of a three-year period of Eucharistic Revival. The goal is to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. The Catholic Schools Office and Faith Formation Office are pleased to announce a contest for students in K to 12 centered on encountering Jesus in the Eucharist. School administrators, teachers, faith formation teachers, and parents/guardians are encouraged to invite students to create an original design or video to address this mission. This contest is open to all K to 12 students living in the Diocese of Erie. All submissions are due to the Catholic Schools Office by March 17, 2023. See each category to determine the delivery method. Winners will be notified via email by March 31, 2023.

## Visual Artwork Specifications and Format

- Artwork must be an original work (not computer generated)
- Students must utilize an 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 11" piece of paper or canvas to create the artwork
- Students may use any of the following media:

<u>Wet Media</u> Acrylic Paint Oil Paint Watercolor Paint Ink Dry Media Charcoal Pastel Colored Pencil Markers Crayons

- The design should occupy no more than the front side of one panel.
- Judged on content, creativity, and appropriateness to the theme "Eucharist, what does it mean to you?".
- Student name, grade, parent/guardian email address, and school/parish should be included, printed on the back of the submission. Mail artwork submission and completed registration form to:

- Content must be original.
- All videos submitted must be suitable for viewing by those of all ages.
  - o Videos deemed inappropriate will not be considered.
- Videos may not feature copyrighted material this includes music and video content, including media ۲ that characters watch within the video. Search for royalty-free music and plan to film additional footage if characters are watching a movie or show that appears on screen.
- Judged on content, creativity, and appropriateness to the theme "Eucharist, what does it mean to you?".
- Completed registration form with student name, grade, parent/guardian email address, and school/parish • should be included in the email with the video submission.
- Upload your video to a file-sharing or social media platform of your choice (Google Drive, Dropbox, TikTok, YouTube, etc.) and send the shareable link of the video to artcontest@eriercd.org. Due to file size limitations, do not attach the original video file to the email.
- The deadline for video submission is March 17, 2023. ۲
