

## Campus Minister, Penn State Behrend (Part-Time)

The campus minister at Penn State Behrend is responsible for the pastoral leadership of the Catholic Community at the university. This includes liturgy, faith formation, pastoral care of the students, faculty, and staff, RCIA and sacramental preparation, programming, and administrative responsibilities. Reports to the Director of Faith Formation for Young Adults and Youth and collaborates with the Priests assigned by the Diocese. The position is non-exempt 10-month position from August 1, through May 31<sup>st</sup>.

### Qualifications

Must have a minimum of a bachelor's degree. Master's in Theology, Pastoral Ministry, or related field preferred.

Should have 1 to 3 years' experience in pastoral ministry. Must be able to work in a team and be an effective communicator. Should have current PA driver's license for intermittent travel. Practicing Catholic in good standing. Willing to work a flexible schedule. Must have all clearances required by the Diocese for the protection of youth. Familiarity with computer programs. Able to work independently with minimal supervision. Knowledge of Catholic church teachings and strategies for ministry with youth and young adults.
