Who we are: Mission and Values

Our parish community is at a turning point. The Role

The Director of Parish Life is a high-level leadership position. Unlike a traditional coordinator, this role focuses on **equipping leaders** rather than just doing the tasks. You will be key in connecting people to our path of discipleship and ensure that our ministries are healthy, engaging, and full of disciples who are on mission.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Strategic Leadership:** Serve as a member of the Parish Leadership Team (PLT), helping to set and execute the vision for the three -church community.
- **Ministry Equipping:** Oversee, disciple, and coordinate volunteer leaders across all ministries (Liturgical, Food Pantry, Bereavement, etc.).
- **Project Management:** Take parish initiatives from "conception to completion," ensuring every event—from a Living Rosary to a Lenten prayer afternoon—reinforces our Catholic identity and mission.
- **One Parish Integration:** Actively work to bring connection between St. Joseph, St. Paul, and Sacred Heart parishioners, fostering a unified culture and "One Parish Mindset."
- **Evangelization:** Connect with new and current parishioners and ensure that every entry point of the parish (hospitality, sacraments, outreach) serves as a bridge to deeper discipleship.

Who You Are

- A **"Galvanizer"**: You are energized by working with and mobilizing others to push initiatives forward and keep momentum around new ideas.
- **Catholic Worldview**: You have a deep knowledge of Catholic traditions and the liturgical calendar and will creatively tie that into year-round parish life.
- **Relational**: You are as comfortable leading a staff meeting as you are praying with volunteers at the Food Pantry.
