Deacon Council Meeting

November 10, 2022

Deacon Ray Sobina opened the meeting with a prayer

Deacon Tom McAraw presented the Diocesan Policy on appropriate Deacon attire. Deacon Council approved it as read.

Deacon Council discussed a suggestion by Deacon Richard Shewman that a Lenten day of recollection for the deacon community on the topic of aging as a spiritual practice/spirituality of aging might be beneficial. Especially given the average age of the deacon community and the number of deacons who passed away this past year. The Deacon Council agreed that it was a good idea.

Deacon Ray Sobina informed Deacon Council that The Deacon Retreat this coming year was planned for Sunday, August 6 to Wednesday, August 9 at Villa Maria Retreat Center and Thursday, September 14 to Sunday, September 17 at Bethany Retreat Center.
