Lectionary Based Catechesis
Lectionary Based catechesis is a curriculum based on the Church's official book of readings for the Sunday liturgy (Lectionary). The curriculum cycles through the Sunday readings using them as the essential guide for the organization of themes and content.
The Lectionary based catechetical process is generally a non -grade specific process designed around groups of children, youth and adults. (For example: Primary age children; Intermediate age children, etc.). This type of non-grade specific grouping makes it a suitable choice for small parish programs. An additional consideration arises because the themes are derived from a single outside source. Everyone in the parish is studying the same theme at the same time which makes intergenerational activities easy to plan.
Lectionary based curriculum work best in an environment where formation is a year round activity. If a traditional schooling-model schedule is imposed on a Lectionary curriculum there are some themes which the Lectionary will cover in the summer months of Ordinary time which would never be considered.
Catechists who are using the Lectionary as the essential basis for the curriculum will need extensive training in the Scriptures. Since many children attend religious education but do not attend liturgy attention will need to be paid to connecting the class work to the Sunday liturgy.
