THIS IS THE LAMB OF GOD By: Thomas Braeger

Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

(1 Peter 8:9)

Could there be a more beautiful gift our Lord has given to us than receiving Him and believing in his Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity each time we attend Mass?

I recently attended a very powerful presentation given by Dr. Jaqueline She discussed numerous Phillips. Eucharistic miracles and the scientific evidence related to them. She explained how God has given us miracles of Eucharistic miracles over the ages in which the host has changed into actual flesh, and not just any flesh, but heart tissue from the left ventricle. This is the part of the heart that sends the blood to nourish the rest of the Body. Could there be any more sensible place where our Lord feeds his Body, the church, than from his Sacred (and real) Heart?

Top scientists analyzed samples in blind studies and agreed that two of the tissue samples are from the same person and the blood type (AB) is consistent with the person of the shroud of Turin. Yes, even though there was a span of 700+ years between the age of the tested samples, they were from the same person. That's not all.... the blood and tissue were not dead, but alive! Further tests revealed that they could establish maternal DNA, but not the paternal. In other words, a mother could be identified but THE spiritual Heavenly Father remains beyond the capability of science to measure!

There are miracles unfolding around us each day. Will you hear about them in the media? Likely not, as they appear to have little interest in promoting "religion" or anything to do with God. The culture seems to be moving more

and more away from God. Ignore the culture and seek to understand that the Living God is around us each and every day. There is no doubt in my mind. As Christians, part of our mission is to convince others of the realness of God. These miracles provide a great way, backed by scientific evidence, to have conversations that begin to open peoples' eyes to our amazing God.

Consider the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It is filled with miracles that defy explanation. The cactus fiber cloak of Saint Juan Diego has an image that cannot be explained by science other than the Hand of the Living God had to have created it. A similar cactus fiber cloak would disintegrate to dust in much less than 100 years; this has been tested in experiments. So nearly 500 year later, the image created by the Hand of the Living God is still present and visible to all who visit it day after day. The gift of the Eucharist is the same: each day, at each Mass we are fed by Living God of the universe!


Amen, amen I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood you will not have life within you. (John 6:53)

Dr. Phillips went on to explain the practice of the Israelites of sacrificing to God animals whereby the blood would fall upon the top of the Ark of the Covenant and what is known as the Mercy Seat of God. The blood was sprinkled by the priest once a year on the top of the Ark for the forgiveness of their sins. In the fullness of time God gave us His Son, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, and His blood was spilled for the forgiveness of our sins

I once heard a talk given a former Jewish woman who converted to Catholicism. In her talk she described the sacrificing of the lamb in the days before Moses received the 10 Commandments; before the Ark of the Covenant and Mercy Seat

existed. She explained her conversion this way. In the days after Abraham but before Moses they would take a lamb to sacrifice to God. When they held the lamb by the neck and severed the vessels in the neck, their sins were washed away as the blood flowed from the lamb. As they understood it, the sin would pass from their body or soul and was washed away by the blood of the lamb offered to God in atonement for their sins. When someone came into her life who explained how Christ's blood washes us clean of our sins, she had an extreme epiphany. The connection between Old and New Testament became clear and she found the *Lamb of God*, her Messiah, and her life was never the same again.

Right after the Eucharistic Miracles event I attended afternoon Mass. I was kneeling after the Lord's prayer and had a vision of sorts. The priest held up the Eucharist and said: Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." I saw our Lord's broken body on the altar and His blood dropping on the Mercy Seat of God and making atonement for our sins. The Mass, for me, will never be the same ever again. Consider that we actually SEE him, Body (heart), Blood (living, type AB), Soul, and Divinity (King of kings and Lord of lords, our new and perfect High Priest), each time we attend Mass and receive Communion. Never cease to take this reality in and be amazed!

They say unforgiveness is like drinking poison and hoping that the other person dies. And yet we keep pouring ourselves drink after drink of this toxic brew.

You can spot an unforgiving person a mile away. They never smile. Their faces are taut. They wreak of bitterness. And the negativity rewards them with higher rates of digestive and heart problems, among other things.

When we fall into unforgiveness and glance into a mirror, we won't recognize the person staring back at us. And still, we foolishly seek revenge. We have been wronged and want to strike back, determining that we hurt and so should they. This is not Christ's example to us.

It is never easy to forgive a wrong done to us, but let's take a good look at Jesus, even if you are someone who doesn't believe that He wasn't the son of God. Even if you believe He was a madman. Even if you believe He was no more than a historical figure trying to make a name for Himself. And especially if you never taken the time to know Him.

Jesus is the Ultimate in forgiveness. He was betrayed by those closest to Him. He was ridiculed, beaten, spat upon, made to wear a crown of thorns and hung on a cross until His life poured out of Him.

To Homeschool or Not to Homeschool?

I had homeschooling on my heart for a year before the 2020-2021 school year began. I was wrestling with God throwing many excuses at him.

"There's no way Caleb will listen to me the same way he listens to his teachers."

"How do I know if it's for me? If it's what you want me to do?"

"How do I convince my husband?"

"If I homeschool, I can only be comfortable with it if we use a specific curriculum. How on EARTH would we come up with the money for that?"

"It might be worse for our family if my kids are home all the time with me. Sometimes I think my head is going to explode with all the chaos."

Through asking all these questions and throwing all these excuses God's way, I was reminded he has a sense of humor. I've learned this time and time again. You'd think it would stick with me!

God Answers Me

Covid hit and I experienced Caleb, my oldest son who was in second grade at the time, being home from school from March to June. Caleb did so well and was extremely motivated for school. We were also blessed with an incredible teacher who made things very easy to follow. It wasn't difficult to have him finish his work each day. He listened to me when I said it was time to do his work with no issues. God addressed that concern.

A week before Caleb was to begin third grade and our twin boys to begin kindergarten at our local public school, which I LOVED, I started listening to Mother Miriam on the Station of the Cross radio station. And of course, someone brought up homeschooling. I

then emailed her and simply asked "How do I know if I am called to homeschool? I've talked to many mothers and I heard them either say 'I knew I was called to homeschool' or 'I knew it wasn't for our family.' How do I know what my call is?"

She actually answered my question on the air the next day! And she said, "This is a great question. You know you are called to homeschool if you are a mother." I was taken back by that. The she went further saying "You may have gone to public school and turned out fine, but schools are VERY different now than they used to be." God answered that question, too.

It just so happened I was surrounded by a group of friends from our parish who homeschool (I see what you did there, Lord) and began asking lots of questions. I decided I loved the Seton Home Study curriculum because everything was already laid out for me. But two huge obstacles remained, that seemed impossible to overcome. My boys were supposed to start school the following week and I had no idea how to convince my husband, whose faith is not as strong as my own, to allow me to homeschool. And I also had no idea where we'd get the extra \$1,000 to pay for the curriculum for the three boys. That was not something we had budgeted for.

I prayed and prayed and prayed. I asked my husband and he asked that I allow him some time to think about it. A couple days later, he and I went on a nice date, bike riding and then dinner afterwards. At dinner he suddenly said, "Your reasons for wanting to homeschool are morally better than my reasons for not wanting them to be homeschooled." I was in shock. God addressed that hurdle as well.

But I still had no idea where we'd get the money for it. Then my husband said, "I just found out I'm getting a bonus next week." Turns out it was \$970. Alright, Lord! I'm hearing you loud and clear!

Swimming in God's Will

The day we officially decided to homeschool and order our curriculum, we also found out we were expecting baby number six. To say I was overwhelmed was an EXTREME understatement. You're just going to throw a little more of Your Will in the mix aren't you, Lord? But I gave it to God, trusted in what he was asking of us, and tried not to think

about how I'd homeschool through morning sickness.

I began our school year completely insecure about everything, but as the weeks went on, it became very natural to us. My boys were extremely motivated to get their work done, which I know is a huge blessing. A few times already, I've come downstairs in the morning and Caleb has said, "Mom, I finished these three subjects while you were all still asleep."

And I realized that instead of it being worse for our family if the kids were home all the time, I noticed I was becoming *more* patient with them. I was learning more about them, about how they learn, about what they are learning. And Caleb at one point, while studying one of his daily religion lessons on the archangels and guardian angels, said to me, "Mom, I really like this." My heart burst.


God Truly Knows Best

I learned that if I opened myself to what God wanted for me and my family, if I gave Him my "yes", He took care of the rest. He always does and always will. Homeschooling may not be in God's will for every family, but God no doubt wanted it for my own. He provided everything we needed when I opened my hands to what he asked of me.

Trust in God, dear mommas. If something is on your heart, talk to God about it and be very open to his will for you. Tell Him your fears about that nudge he's giving you because they are very real to him as well. Be honest; He completely understands. He knows what is best for you and absolutely WILL provide if you're open to his plan for you and your family.

Is there something on your heart you feel God is calling you to? Are you avoiding it or embracing it? Have you sat down in the stillness and had a conversation with God about it? Consider journaling, starting with prayer, and seeing where
